Remarked the angel, 'What a creation!'*

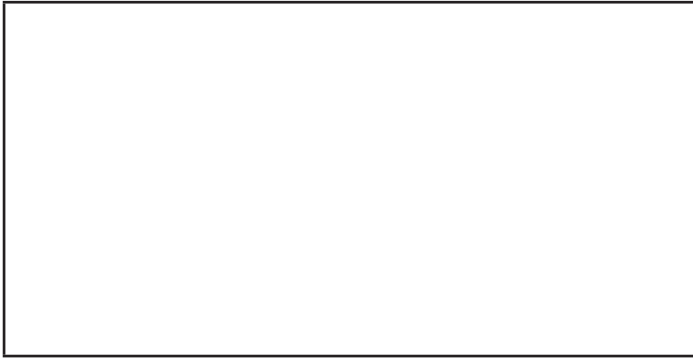
*God the Almighty will hear their call

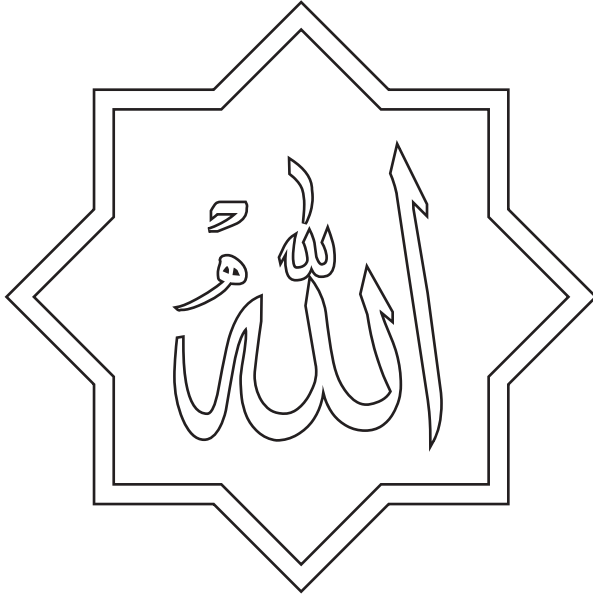



O do come quickly now and do not stall*


*Hurry up and leave your comfortable bed
